Pre-course task

Your task is to:

- 1. Find a game clip of a player performing a skill to move with the ball OR move the ball.
- 2. Analyse the skill by identifying its key elements with respect to ball, body, head, movement, grip etc.
- 3. Design a game context drill where the skill may be developed.

You should send your analysis and plan to the course email address before the course starts.

You will use have 5 minutes to present your task on day one of the course.


